## VACCINATION REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL FOREIGN NATIONALS ALLOWED TO ENTER THE PHILIPPINES

Pursuant to Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging infectious Diseases (IATF-EID) Resolution No. 157 series of 2022 dated 13 January 2022, beginning 16 February 2022, proof of full vaccination shall be made a requirement for entry of all foreign nationals allowed to enter the Philippines:

An individual shall be considered as having been fully vaccinated for COVID-19:

- a. More than or equal to 2 weeks after having received the second dose in a 2-dose series, or
- b. More than or equal to 2 weeks after having received a single-dose vaccine.
- c. The vaccines administered to the individual are included in any of the following:
  - i. Emergency Use Authorization (EUA) List or Compassionate Special Permit (CSP) issued by the Philippine Food and Drug Administration; or
  - ii. Emergency Use Listing of the World Health Organization.
- d. Foreign nationals must have the following proofs of vaccination against COVID-19 recognized under existing IATF regulations:
  - World Health Organization International Certificates of Vaccination and Prophylaxis;
  - ii. VaxCertPH; or
  - iii. National/state digital certificate of the foreign government which has accepted VaxCertPH under a reciprocal arrangement unless otherwise permitted by the IATF.
